Student Visa Guidance & Policy Framework

1. Our Student Visa Support System

Hizashi Japanese Academy provides structured guidance for students planning to study in Japan under a Student Visa.

Our role is to prepare, organize, and professionally guide you through the entire process — from eligibility screening to arrival preparation.

We do not guarantee visa approval. We prepare you to qualify.

2. Eligibility Requirements

Before starting the process, students must meet the following basic criteria:

- Minimum 12 years of formal education
- Age typically between 17 – 35 years
- Clean immigration history
- Genuine intention to study in Japan
- Financial capacity to support study and living expenses

Final eligibility depends on Japanese school and immigration review.

3. Registration & Screening Process

To initiate the visa pathway:

1. Complete the official Student Visa Registration Form.
2. Submit preliminary academic and passport copies.
3. Pay the official registration fee (non-refundable).
4. Attend initial screening interview conducted by Hizashi.


Only students who pass internal screening will proceed to Japanese school interview preparation.

4. Interview Preparation

Hizashi provides:

- Structured interview coaching
- Personal statement guidance
- Japan study purpose clarification
- Mock interviews

Attendance for interview practice sessions is mandatory.

5. Documentation & COE Application

After successful school interview approval:

We begin COE (Certificate of Eligibility) file preparation.

Required documents may include:

- Valid Passport
- Educational Certificates
- Academic Transcripts
- Financial Proof (Bank statements / Sponsor income proof)
- Sponsor documents (if applicable)

- Personal history statement
- Japanese language certificates

Incomplete or false documentation will immediately stop the process.

COE processing time approximately takes 6 months depending on intake and immigration workload.

6. Financial Responsibility Policy

Students must demonstrate sufficient financial stability for:

- Tuition fees
- Living expenses
- Accommodation
- Insurance

Sponsors must provide legitimate income proof.

Immigration authorities verify financial credibility carefully.

7. COE Issuance & Visa Application (VFS Stage)

Once the COE is issued:

- Students will apply for the Student Visa through the relevant visa submission center.
- Hizashi will assist in preparing required documents for submission.

Final visa approval is determined solely by the Embassy / Consulate of Japan.

8. Pre-Departure Guidance

After visa approval, Hizashi provides:

- Travel preparation briefing
- Entry procedures explanation

- Airport arrival guidance
 - Accommodation advice
 - Basic Japan living orientation

9. Post-Arrival Advisory Support

Upon arrival in Japan, students will receive guidance regarding:

- Residence registration at City Hall
- Health insurance enrollment
- Bank account opening
- Part-time work regulations
- Student responsibilities in Japan

Students must follow Japanese laws strictly.

10. Important Policy Notice

- Registration fees are non-refundable.
- Providing false information will result in immediate termination of application.
- Visa approval is not guaranteed.
- Immigration decisions are final and cannot be influenced.
